Policy Title: STUDENT TRANSFER IN

Policy Code No. 501.10

Students who transfer into the school district must meet the immunization and age requirements set out for students who initially enroll in the school district. The school district reserves the right to deny admission to any nonresident student.

The school district shall request the student's cumulative records from the previous school district. If the student cannot offer proof of grade level, the superintendent or designee will make the grade level determination. The superintendent or designee may require testing or other information to determine the grade level.

The superintendent or designee shall determine the amount of credits to be transferred. If the student has not previously attended an accredited school, the superintendent or designee shall be responsible for the decision to accept or reject credits or grades.

The school district may deny admission if the student is not willing to provide the necessary information.
