Policy Title: EXCLUSION FOR COMMUNICABLE DISEASE AND RE-ADMITTANCE

Policy Code No. 504.2R

A signed permit from a doctor may be required before a pupil may re-enter school after having had the following diseases:

DISEASE	MINIMUM EXCLUSION FROM SCHOOL
Chickenpox crusted.	Until blisters are
Erthemia Infectiosum (Fifth Disease)	After diagnosis no exclusion from school. Alert pregnant women.
German Measles (Rubella)	7 days from onset of rash. Keep away from pregnant women.
Impetigo	Cover lesions when attending school.
Infectious Hepatitis	14 days from onset of clinical disease, and at least 7 days from onset of jaundice.
Measles	7 days from onset of rash. From first symptoms until 4 days after appearance of rash.
Meningococcal Meningitis	Until physician permits return.
Mumps	9 days or until swelling disappears.
Pediculosis (lice)	Immediatley after adequate treatment to live lice.
Ringworm	Exclude from gymnasium, swimming pools, and contact sports until physician permits return.

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Scabies	Until adequately treated by physician.
Scarlet fever, Scarlatina, Strep Throat	7 days from onset if untreated or 24 hours after antibiotic.
Tuberculosis	Until 3 consecutive negative sputum smears collected on different days. Written doctor's permission is required to return to school.
Whooping cough	21 days from beginning of whoop or at least 5 days of antibiotics have been completed.

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
