

# Series 600 – Educational Program

Policy Title: INSUFFICIENT CLASSROOM SPACE

Policy Code No. 603.11

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Insufficient classroom space exists when conditions adversely affect the implementation of the educational philosophy and program of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall determine insufficient classroom space on a case by case basis. Criteria to be used by the Board of Directors in its determination may include, but not be limited to, available personnel, grade level, educational program, instructional method, physical space, equipment and materials available, finances available, facilities either being planned or currently under construction, sharing agreements in force, bargaining agreements in force, and district's goals and objectives.

The Board of Directors shall not hire additional instructional staff in order to accommodate open enrollment students. Ratios shall be maintained, as required by law, for special education students.

This policy shall be reviewed by the Board of Directors annually between the months of May and October.
