Policy Title: District Inclement Weather Response Procedures Policy Code No. 711.8R1

Inclement weather conditions can include such things as snowstorms, dangerous wind chills, ice, fog or any number of other potential threatening weather conditions. When the forecast predicts inclement weather conditions the following occurs:

Morning Procedures

The district periodically checks a. transportation supervisor weather conditions throughout the night. The superintendent of schools will be involved the evaluation the weather in and road conditions. These two people will make the decision on delays cancellations earliest school and at the reasonable time.

b. school day schedule is changed due to weather conditions, the transportation supervisor, the superintendent of schools and will responsible to call the radio and television stations The will alert the public. district very clearly identify/publish stations will notified. iust which be Αll building administrators will immediately contacted be phone, electronic or other means.

Early Dismissal Procedures

When the weather forecast predicts inclement weather conditions while school is in session, the following occurs:

- a. The transportation supervisor monitors radio stations, the national weather service in with visual Des well as local conditions Moines, as road road checks driving district bus routes. by
- b. lf weather conditions warrant early dismissal, then all area an radio and television stations will be alerted about the schedule change one to dismissal. ΑII building at least hour prior administrators immediately and bus drivers are contacted by phone.
- c. The transportation supervisor continues to monitor weather conditions by driving district bus routes.
 - 1. If weather conditions for remain safe student transport, all home students will be returned according the adjusted early dismissal schedule.

The district will continue to offer shelter to all students until weather conditions improve their and the parents/guardians pick arrange to up children.

Mid-Route Turn Around

If buses have already been sent out, and weather conditions deteriorate to what the driver feels is an unsafe situation for a school bus, the driver may:

- off the roadway safe place with hazard lights flashing a. pull to а for conditions and wait to improve;
- b. if necessary, stop pull in to the next available safe stop and radio for parent/guardian and pick up;
- c. if unsafe to stop at а student's stop because of poor visibility, the driver leave the student may request with another route. Driver shall notify office family on the and wait for approval.
- d. possible, turn around mid-route, if and bring students back to if felt to risk Bus the high school it is be a to continue. drivers duty they are to remain on until are dismissed.

Any or all of these decisions by the driver will be respected as a good judgment call for the safety of the children and not an indication of lack of competent driving skill.
