Policy Title: EDUCATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR BUILDING

Policy Code No. 901.5

The superintendent and staff, with the help of consultants, citizen advisory groups, and the Board of Directors, shall prepare educational specifications which may be used by the architect in planning the building's elements in such a way that will encourage the teaching and learning activities which are to take place within it.

The educational specifications shall provide the architect with an inventory of program requirements, a statement of functional program relationships, a definition of the number and character of classrooms, a description of needed specialized instructional facilities, the financial resources available for the project, and the educational requirements for any areas being considered for construction or upgrade.
