Series 200 – Board of Directors

Policy Title: Vacancies

Policy Code No. 202.4

A vacancy requiring Board action occurs when a Board member resigns, forfeits or otherwise leaves the office. A vacancy also includes, but is not limited to, the following: failure to be properly elected, failure to qualify within the time fixed by law, failure to reside in the school district, a court order declaring the seat vacant.

If a vacancy occurs prior to the expiration of a term of office, the vacancy shall be filled by Board appointment within 30 days of the vacancy. The board shall publish notice stating that the board intends to fill the vacancy by appointment, but the electors of the school district have the right to file a petition requiring the vacancy be filled by a special election. The newly appointed Board member shall hold the position until the next scheduled school election. At that time the appointed Board member may run for a 4 year term, if one is available, or run for the remainder of the unexpired term.

If the Board is unable to fill a vacancy by appointment within 30 days after the vacancy occurs, the Board Secretary shall call a special election to be held no sooner than 60 days and no later than 70 days after the vacancy occurred. The Board member elected at the special election shall serve the remaining portion of the unexpired term.
