

Series 200 – Board of Directors

Policy Title: **Vice-President**

Policy Code No. 206.2

The Vice-President shall serve in the absence of the President and shall perform such other duties as may be assigned by the President or the Board. The Vice President automatically succeeds to the presidency should the president leave office.

The vice-president of the board is elected by a majority vote each year at the organizational meeting or annual meeting if it's not an election year. The term of service will be one-year.

The vice-president will accept control of the meeting from the president when the president wishes to make or second a motion. The vice-president will take an active role in board decisions by discussing and voting on matters before the board in the same manner as other board members.
