## **Embargoed Data - Newton Graduation & Dropout Rates**

Superintendent Callaghan shared data released from the Iowa Department of Education regarding graduation and dropout rates. 2018 Newton Community School District graduation rate was 92.98% compared to the State of Iowa 91.4%. The 2017 – 2018 Newton Community School District (7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>) dropout rate was 1.6% compared to the State of Iowa 1.83%.
