ALL ENROLLED STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE A FREE BREAKFAST & LUNCH DAILY

Newton Schools started universal free meal service on Sept. 8th. The free meals are made available through the USDA and are now approved through the end of the school year.

The nationwide waivers will allow any child enrolled in Newton Schools to receive free meals operating under the SFSP guidelines. The waivers will run through the end of 2020-21 School Year. Specifics of the waivers include:

- Allowing SFSP meals to be served in all areas and at no cost
- Permitting meals to be served outside of the typically-required group settings and meal times
- Waiving meal pattern requirements as necessary
- Allowing parents and guardians to pick-up meals for their children on remote learning days
- Newton Schools will provide a free lunch and breakfast for all enrolled students under SFSP guidelines

Please continue to fill out the free and reduced meal applications to be approved for a free or reduced fee waiver. Also, make sure to go to the www.newtoncsd.org website to fill out a remote meal form if you would like to pick up meals on Mondays. The form is located under the Return to Learn then Food Service section. Parents must fill out a form for each child that would like to pick up a meal on Mondays.
