Thomas Jefferson Elementary (continued)	In pr *	□ File	Changes to Drop Off / Pick Up Process & Bell Schedule At the March 10, 2025 board meeting Jolene Comer, Principal (TJ) gave a thorough description of the upcoming changes at Thomas Jefferson Elementary regarding their drop off and pick up process and how this will also affect the bell schedule. The changes began on April 15, 2025 and will last for the remainder of the 2024 - 2025 school year, and are necessary due to the next construction phase which will affect access to the north driveway and current bus lane area. The project timeline, beginning in the Spring 2025, will allow for this construction phase to be completed by the Fall 2025. On March 11, 2025 a communication was sent from Mrs. Comer via ParentSquare to TJ families explaining the temporary changes.
