Policy Title: STUDENT FEES AND WAIVERS

Policy Code No. 505.13

The Board of Directors believes students should respect school district property and assist in its preservation for future use by others. Students may be assessed fees, fines, or charges for the materials needed in a course, for participating in activities, for overdue school materials, or for misuse of school property.

The superintendent may inform the Board of Directors of the dollar amount to be charged to students or others for fees, fines, or charges annually. Parents/guardians of students meeting specific financial eligibility standards will be eligible for a waiver of student fees or a reduction of student fees based upon the request of the parents/guardians. It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent, in conjunction with the principals, to develop administrative regulations regarding this policy.
