Series 500 – Student Personnel

Policy Title: INTERROGATION OF STUDENTS

Policy Code No. 505.7

A student may not be interrogated, other than by school personnel, during the school day or periods of extracurricular or co-curricular activities unless the building principal or any other delegated staff member is present when possible.

If the reason for the interrogation is child abuse and the department of human services assessor states that the child will be interviewed without his or her parent(s)/guardian(s) and the school is the appropriate setting for the interview, school administrators will allow the interrogations without contacting the parents/guardians. It is the responsibility of the department of human services assessor of abuse cases to determine who will be present during the interview.

A student may not be removed from school grounds without the knowledge of the building principal or designee and without proper warrant or papers. Protection of constitutional rights shall be the administrator's first priority.
