

Series 600 – Educational Program

Policy Title: SCHOOL DISTRICT INSTRUCTIONAL ORGANIZATION

Policy Code No. 601.1

The school district offers an educational program for grades pre-kindergarten through twelve. The levels of instruction are organized by the following levels:

- Grades pre-kindergarten through six shall attend an elementary school.
- Grades seven and eight shall attend the middle school.
- Grades nine through twelve shall attend the senior high school.

Each school building will have a principal responsible for the administration and management of the school building.

The school district offers the following:

- A pre-kindergarten special education program for children ages 3 through 6.
- Basics and Beyond High School which provides educational opportunities for older high school students who are behind in earning credits for graduation, who are at-risk of dropping out of school, or who have dropped out of school.
