Policy Title: TECHNOLOGY

Policy Code No. 602.11

The Board of Directors supports the innovative use of technology in the delivery of the educational program. The Board of Directors encourages school district personnel to investigate efficient and effective ways to utilize instructional television, audiovisual materials, computers, and other technological advances as a part of the curriculum.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent or designee to develop a plan for the use of technology in the curriculum and to evaluate it annually. The superintendent or designee shall report the results of the evaluation and make a recommendation to the Board of Directors regarding the use of technology in the curriculum.
